2nd Transnational Project Meeting Report
28th & 29th September, 2023

This interim report aims to present the findings and analyze the level of satisfaction expressed by project members regarding the second Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) that took place in La Laguna, Tenerife. The 2nd TPM was a crucial event designed to foster coordination, and project progress among the consortium's partners. The satisfaction survey was conducted immediately after the end of the TPM to evaluate its effectiveness and gather valuable feedback for future improvement.

Methodology:

The [survey](#) collected responses from project partners using a 4-point scale, ranging from "Strongly agree" to "Strongly disagree," to assess different aspects of the TPM. The questionnaire comprised statements covering various dimensions, such as event planning, time allocation, content relevance, learning applicability, communication effectiveness, organizational handling, venue and cultural events suitability, and overall satisfaction. The partners completed the survey between October 6th and November 10th, 2023.

Findings:

The results from the survey indicate a remarkably positive reception among the project members regarding the TPM. Across all evaluated aspects, the overwhelming majority of participants either "strongly agreed" or "agreed," signifying their satisfaction with the event.

1. Event Planning and Time Allocation:

84.6% of respondents both "strongly agreed" that the TPM was well planned, and are convinced that the time allocated to each part of the event was realistic. This indicates that the organizers successfully orchestrated the TPM, ensuring a smooth flow of activities and excellent time management.

2. Relevance of Content and Effective Mix of Activities:

92.3% of participants "strongly agreed" that the content presented during the TPM was clearly linked to the objectives of the project. Additionally, the mix of activities related to the project objectives was strongly deemed effective by 76.9% of respondents, highlighting the event's ability to address critical project aspects comprehensively.



3. Learning Applicability:

The TPM succeeded in demonstrating its practical value, with all participants either "strongly agreeing" (61.5%) or "agreeing" (38.5%) that they could clearly see how to apply what they had learned in their respective organizations. This indicates that the TPM provided valuable insights and knowledge transfer to enhance participants' work.

4. Effective Communication:

Communication between partners during the TPM was rated highly effective, with 76.9% of respondents "strongly agreeing" and 23.1% "agreeing." This demonstrates clear communication channels and effective collaboration among the consortium members during the event.

5. Organizational Handling and Administrative Details:

The organizers received high praise for efficiently handling practical details, as 92.3% of respondents "strongly agreed" in this regard. Similarly, administrative matters, such as attendance sheet signing and certificates, were well managed, leading to unanimous strong satisfaction of the participants.

6. Venue Suitability:

Regarding the venue for workshops, what could be better than a workshop at the central campus of a university, generally defined as an institution of study and research devoted to the transmission of knowledge and the dissemination of research results? 84.6% of the respondents "strongly agreed" that the rooms, situated at the heart of the University of La Laguna (ULL) provided an adequate and appropriate space to work in.

7. Program and Materials:

Participants found the program and materials provided during the TPM to be appropriate and informative, with 69.2% "strongly agreeing" and 30.8% "agreeing."

8. The cultural events:

An innovation during this 2nd TPM was the organization of cultural activities. Given that the TPM was held in the historical city of La Laguna, all the participants really appreciate the inclusion of cultural activities in the timetable (92.3% of all "strongly agreed" about the usefulness, good planification and organisation of the activities within this part of the programme and 7.7% found it interesting).

Overall Satisfaction:



The majority of respondents were completely satisfied with the 2nd TPM, with 81.8% "strongly agreeing" and 18.2% "agreeing" to this statement. The comments made by the respondents at the end of the questionnaire support this general satisfaction, appreciating the organisation as a whole as well as the lunches staged. These positive feedbacks indicate a successful and fulfilling TPM experience for the participating project members.

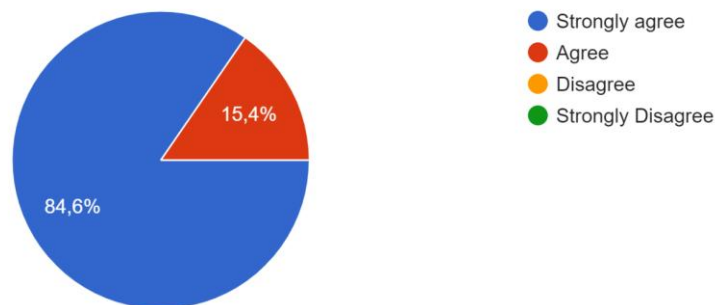
Conclusion:

The short joint staff event was well planned.

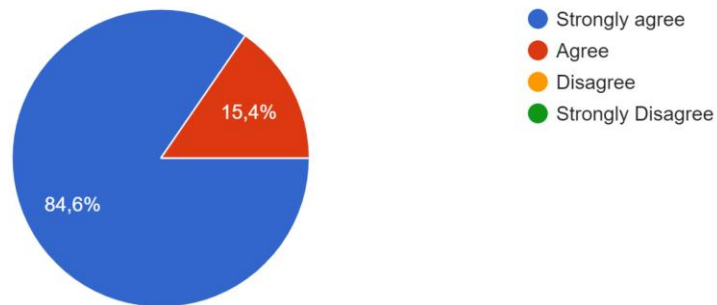

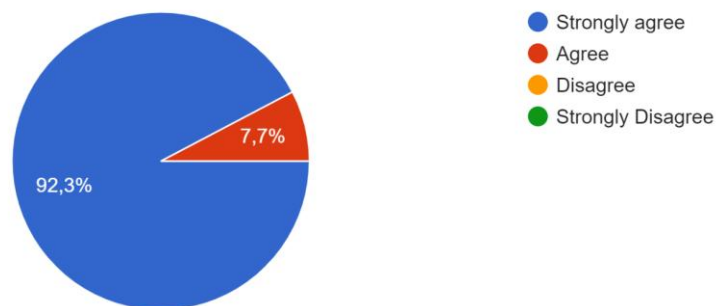
The time allocated to each part of event was realistic.

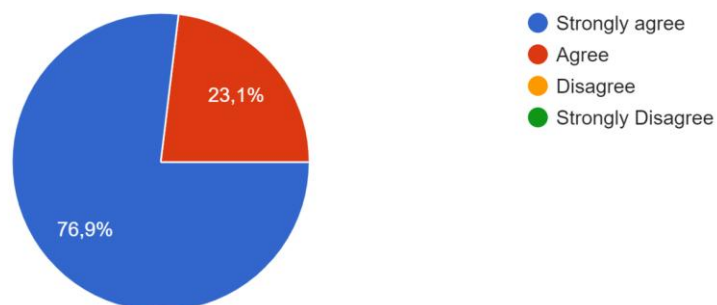
The content was clearly linked to the objectives of the project.

The mix of the activities related to the objectives of the project was effective.

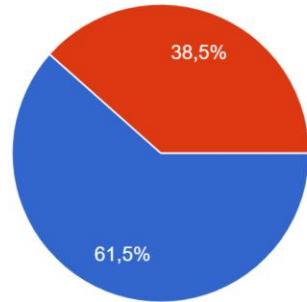

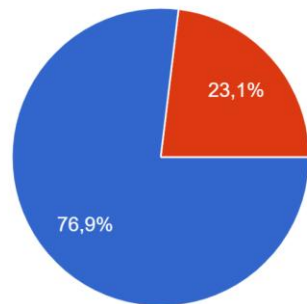

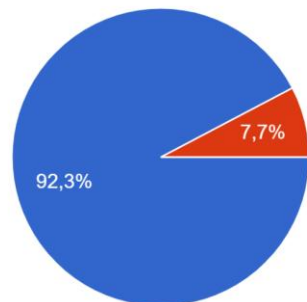

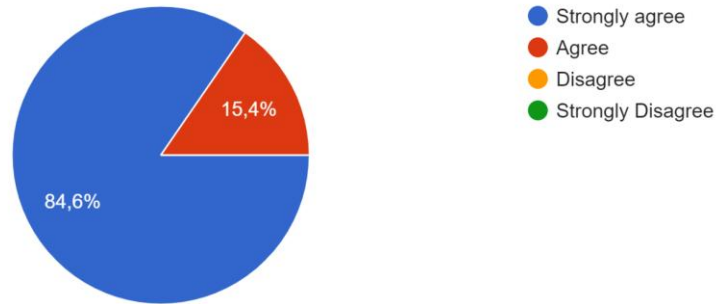

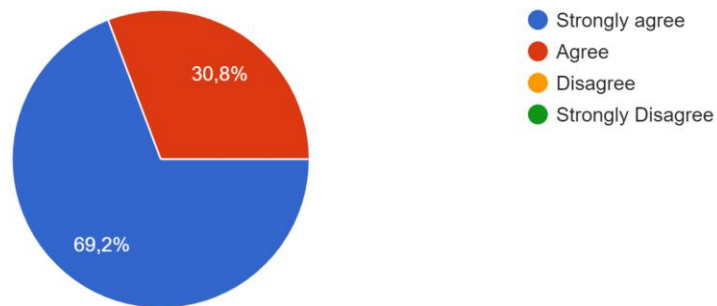
The rooms for workshops were an adequate and appropriate space to work in.

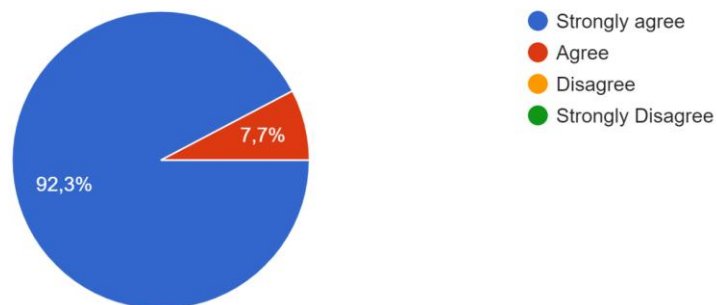
The program and materials provided were appropriate and informative.

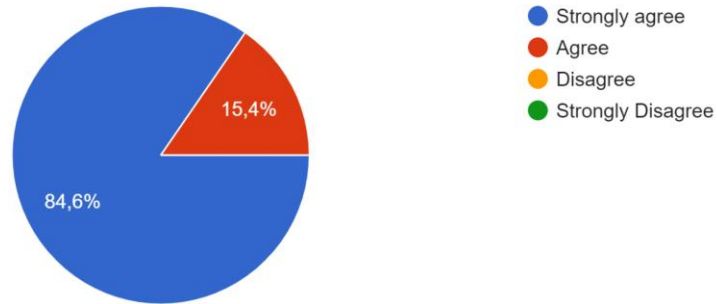
